Waste and Recycling Service Information

Dear Scott Twp. Resident,
Your community provides a comprehensive solid waste program designed to encourage recycling and waste reduction, reduce litter in our neighborhoods and ensure that waste is disposed of in an environmentally responsible manner. This guide includes various services that are available to residents. WM pledges to provide the high-quality service residents expect and deserve.

REGULAR CURBSIDE COLLECTION: Trash will be collected once every week on **MONDAY**. Recycling will be collected every other week, please see the calendar to identify your collection week. Place material at the curb after 6 p.m. on the prior day or before 6 a.m. on the scheduled collection day.

SERVICE INQUIRES: Residents should contact WM to report a missed pick up. A representative can be reached at 1-800-866-4460 or through live chat at www.wm.com. In the event of inclement weather, visit www.wm.com/alerts for updates, delays & cancellations.

HOLIDAY SERVICE: Please reference the calendar for observed holidays.





GUIDELINES FOR COLLECTION: Residents should use their provided trash cart for collection.

- Garbage should be properly secured in your provided cart. Additional garbage beyond what fits in the cart can be placed in bags or additional cans alongside the cart for collection.
- Residents must fill their provided cart first before placing material outside of the cart.
- Residents are permitted 2 bulk items per week. Bulk items include chairs, tables, couches, lamps, etc.
- Additional carts can be purchased directly from WM at a cost of \$85.00. To purchase an additional cart, residents should call WM.
- Grass clippings and weeds should be in plastic bags.
- Furniture items, appliances, household goods and disassembled children's swing sets (cut to 4-foot length) will be accepted at curbside.
- Carpet should be rolled and tied in lengths not to exceed 48 inches so that one person can lift.
- Empty paint cans and dried paint are acceptable. Paint can be dried by air drying or soaking up with newspaper or kitty litter. Lids should be left off.

EXCLUDED ITEMS:

- Building material may be picked up for a fee by contacting WM at 800-866-4460
- Hazardous Household Waste and Electronic Waste (including paint, thinners, cleaners, pesticides/herbicides, etc.) - see PA Resources Council website for county events (www.prc.org)
- Automobile parts including wheel rims and tires
- Trees, branches and bushes
- Ashes from furnaces and fireplaces
- Stones and dirt

APPLIANCES CONTAINING REFRIGERANT: WM will collect such items as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, water coolers, etc.; however, the item must have a sticker certifying that the refrigerant has been removed. If it does not have the sticker, it will not be picked up. It is unlawful for the contractor to dispose of these items containing refrigerant. When purchasing a new appliance, have the store dispose of the old appliance to save the cost of having the refrigerant removed.

AUTOMATED RECYCLING SERVICE: Residents will receive every other week curbside recycling collection. Please reference the calendar to identify your service week. Recyclables will be collected using automated collection trucks. Residents should use their provided recycling carts and recyclables must be placed loose in the cart. Material outside of the cart will not be collected. Carts must be placed three feet away from all objects, including your second cart, mailbox, car or trees. The lid opening should face the street with the wheels of the cart facing your house.

2023 RECYCLING PROGRAM INFORMATION: WM is asking your community to help combat recycling contamination. For programs to be successful, all participants must make an effort to practice good recycling habits.

- No plastic bags of any kind will be accepted. Place material loose in your recycling cart.
- Make sure you are only recycling plastic bottles, jugs and jars. Any other plastic shape must go in the trash.
- Glass is no longer accepted for curbside recycling – talk to your municipality about local drop off programs.
- Containers that held food should be rinsed free of food debris and liquid.
- Shredded paper is not accepted.
